- Please complete this application for permission to be included in our Project LEAP program.
- With your student's specific learning standards in mind, create a short assignment designed around the learning resources found at the St. George Children's Museum.
- Clearly define the assignment objectives, activity, and the Utah Common Core standards which will be met.
- Please allow 48 hours (or 2 business days) for the application to be reviewed and approved.
- Upon approval, you will be contacted and passes for your students (one free admission when accompanied by a paying adult) will be available for you to pick up at the museum during regular business hours.
- Passes will be valid from the time the assignment opens until the designated due date. Please note that we will not accept any passes after May 1st of that year.
- Each educator may submit up to 3 assignments per school year (Aug 31-May 1).
- Please have your student remove the completion slip and turn it in at the museum front desk. From here, we will keep track of those who have completed the assignment, and notify the teacher after the due date has passed.
- Only one submission per student per assignment.
- We will group participants into 3 categories: public, charter/private, and homeschool/other. At the end of the school year, the class with the best participation in each of the 3 will be invited to a private after-hours museum party.
